Greetings Omega Sisters!

Back in July, a couple of us hatched this idea to try to organize a reunion to commemorate the $100^{\rm th}$ anniversary of the founding of Omega Chapter of Alpha Delta Pi at LSU. Up until this point, we have relied on spreading the word to other sisters via telephone calls, email, Facebook, the $A\Delta\Pi$ website, and *The Adelphean*. We recruited volunteers to serve on the planning committee and have held several meetings to begin the process of organizing a centennial reunion. We obtained the membership roster with over 1,000 Omegas from Executive Office. We have been searching for lost sisters, validating mailing addresses and adding e-mail addresses to our database. We have also built up a treasury which now has sufficient funds to support the mailing of this newsletter to over 750 Omegas with addresses in our database. Despite our best efforts, some of you are learning of this reunion for the first time as you read this newsletter.

Organizing the reunion has been a grass roots effort from the start. Little did we know how much interest and enthusiasm there would be for this celebration! What began as a grass roots effort to plan this event has grown into a well-oiled machine consisting of Omegas from across the country contributing their time and expertise in organizing the event. - Scan in the images at 300 dpi (dots per inch) this will make the image file large enough to be used in the video
- Scan as a .jpg file extension
- Scan as the 'best' level of image
- Please note that if a file size is too small, the image will not enlarge well in the video.
